WHEREAS, the Board of School Trustees is the governing body of Greensburg Community School Corporation, Decatur County, Indiana, and

WHEREAS, the Board did advertise, hold a public hearing, and publicly adopt a Capital Projects Fund Plan/Budget for 2024-2025-2026 as per I. C. 21-2-15, and

WHEREAS, expenditure calculations used to prepare the Capital Projects Fund Plan/Budget and establish tax levies and rates for advertisement are projections of events that may take place over the next six months, and

WHEREAS, the Board of School Trustees is required to advertise the 2024 Budget six months prior to implementation, and

WHEREAS, the Board of School Trustees wishes to cap the 2024 Capital Projects Fund tax rate on the patrons of Greensburg to produce levies to fund the 2024 Capital Projects Fund Plan/Budget.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of School Trustees grant the appropriate authority to Mr. Tom Hunter, Superintendent, to lower planned expenditures in the Capital Projects Fund Plan/Budget for 2024-2025-2026 where necessary to more accurately reflect necessary expenditures January 1 through December 31, 2024 on School Budget Form 4B "Estimate of Funds to be Raised", Line 1.
