Kindergarten ONLY Language Arts Identification:

85% and above on CogAT Test, Measures of Ability

OR

MCLASS Amplify Reading, Measures of Achievement

Total Composite Above Level (blue)

AND

30 words, Word Reading Fluency (WRF)

Grades 2 & 5 Language Arts and K, 2 & 5 Math Identification:

99% and above on NWEA Test, Measures of Achievement

OR

85% and above on CogAT Test, Measures of Ability

OR

80% and above on CogAT

AND

80% and above on NWEA Tests

AND

teacher recommendation

Criteria to test students:

NWEA data, 80% and above

MCLASS data, above level (total composite and WRF)
